





Use measuring tape to determine tree or column thickness.

Important Tip!
The top portion of the measuring tape corresponds with the HELIX, the bottom corresponds with the TEE. Use the letters and numbers to easily adjust the Tree Hugger[®] for a perfect fit.



Align the arrow on the bottom helix to the appropriate number on the top helix. Insert top helix into bottom helix and firmly tighten thumb screw.

Important Tip!
The top helix has numbers on the male end and nothing on the female end. The bottom helix has letters on the male end and an arrow on the female end.

Wrap the helix around the tree or column. Visually choose the desired height before attaching the fork assembly (step 4).


Important Tip!
Squeeze hands together

Note:
Larger trees will fill gap & smaller trees leave a bigger gap.




Attach pot loops to the fork assembly and firmly tighten compression nuts.

Attach top pot loop to the arm connector and helix connector, tighten compression fittings.

Important Tip!
Pot loops can be adjusted to a number of angles.



Lift up and out


Align the correct letter on bottom helix to the arrow on fork assembly. Attach the fork assembly and top pot loop. Tighten screw on top of tee.
*Make sure the fork is against tree.

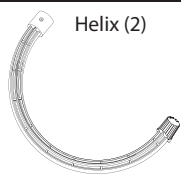
When installed properly, three points of the Tree Hugger[®] must make firm contact with the tree or column.

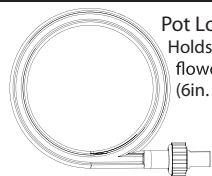


The tee and fork will support a hanging plant up to 15 lbs. The bottom loops will support 5-6 pound potted plants. Place lighter potted plants in the top loop.

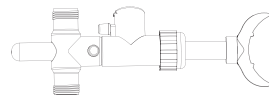

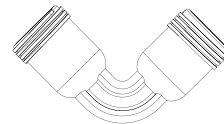

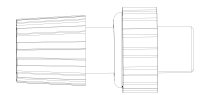
Pot Loop (3)
